El Futuro del No Creyente #1

Lucas 16:19-31

Las últimas dos semanas estuvimos hablando del futuro de los creyentes. La pregunta ahora es, ¿Qué sucederá con los no creyentes?

I. El Futuro Inmediato: ¿Qué Sucede Cuando Mueren?

- a. **Lucas 16:19-31**
- b. Están en un lugar de tormentos (vv.23-25)
- c. Están separados de los muertos creyentes (vv. 25-26)
- d. Están conscientes de su rechazo de Dios (vv. 27-30)

II. El Castigo Sobre Este Mundo – La Tribulación

- a. **Daniel 9:27**
- b. Después de que Jesús tome a los creyentes, vendrá un tiempo de dificultad donde la gente buscará un líder
- c. El Anticristo tomará ese lugar
- d. Este periodo durará 7 años, pero el Anticristo traicionará a la gente a la mitad de ese tiempo

III. El Juicio Continuo – La Gran Tribulación

- a. **Apocalipsis 5-18**
- b. Habrá 21 juicios, en tres etapas de 7, cada etapa peor que la anterior.
- c. La gente al principio se dará cuenta de su error por no creerle a Dios (**Apocalipsis 6:16-17**)
- d. Pero, aun así, muchos seguirán con un corazón duro rechazando a Dios (**Apocalipsis 9:20-21; 16:9; 11; 21**)

Entre todo esto, la única buena noticia es que aun ahí algunos tendrán esperanza. Será un tiempo muy difícil para poder ser creyente (**Daniel 12:10; Marcos 13:20; Apocalipsis 7:14**), pero todavía algunos serán salvos. Pero ¿Por qué esperar esto cuando Dios ha provisto el rescate? Y para los que hemos creído, necesitamos seguir compartiendo, para que, aun si no creen ahora, puedan creer después de que Jesús tome a Su iglesia.

Beginning with the End in Mind

The Future of the Non-believer #1

Luke 16: 19-31

The last two weeks we have been talking about the future of believers. The question now is, what will happen to non-believers?

I. The Immediate Future: What Happens When They Die?

- **Luke 16: 19-31**
- They are in a place of agony (vv.23-25)
- They are separated from the believers who died (vv. 25-26)
- They are aware of their rejection of God (vv. 27-30)

II. The Punishment On This World - The Tribulation

- **Daniel 9:27**
- After Jesus takes the believers, there will come a time of hardship where people will look for a leader
- The Antichrist will take that place
- This period will last 7 years, but the Antichrist will betray those people halfway through that time.

III. The Ongoing Judgment - The Great Tribulation

- **Revelation 5-18**
- There will be 21 judgments, in three stages of 7, each stage worse than the last.
- People at first will realize their mistake of not believing God (**Revelation 6: 16-17**)
- But even so, many will continue with a hard heart rejecting God (**Revelation 9: 20-21; 16: 9; 11; 21**)

Among all this, the only good news is that even then, some will have hope. It will be a very difficult time to be a believer (**Daniel 12:10; Mark 13:20; Revelation 7:14**), but some will still be saved. But why wait for this when God has provided an exit?

And for those of us who have believed, we need to keep sharing, so that even if they don't believe now, they can believe after Jesus takes His church with Him.

To avoid spreading disease while we are in these facilities, please follow these instructions:

Use antibacterial gel and masks.

Leave at least 6 feet of space (3 chairs) between families.

Use the foot pull to open the door to the hallway and gently push it when coming back.

Children must stay with their parents. They should not sit with their friends. During the message, they will be able to draw and write things related to the message. If they do a good job, the children's ministry will have something special for them. Please save the crayon boxes for the following weeks.

Please do not go through the blocked areas or exit through other exterior doors. The playground area is closed too.

Please follow social distancing rules - no physical contact (no hugs or kisses) or standing/sitting too close. Please wait your turn during tithes and offerings, going to the bathroom, etc.

If you feel sick, please return home.
